

SAFETY AND SECURITY:

Activate Sport prioritises the safety, security, well-being and enjoyment of each camper.

Activate Sport staff are all qualified Teachers or specialists in their sport or activity and are carefully chosen for their positive and encouraging attitudes and experience of working with children of all ages and abilities.

All staff and coaches hold current CRB (Criminal Records Bureau) clearance and at least 1 member of staff will have an up to date First Aid qualification (usually the manager)

As part of Activate Sport's commitment to quality provision, maximum group sizes are a ration of 1 coach to 12 campers, further reduced to a maximum of 1 coach to 8 campers for children aged under 8.

A key feature of Activate Sport is that all sport and activity programmes are age-appropriate and in accordance with Ofsted guidelines children younger than 8yrs do not participate in sport with children more than 2 years older.

Activate Sport operate a secure registration and collection procedure:

Daily registration and collection procedures for every camper are a very important security feature on an Activate Sport Camp.

There is always one designated registration and collection point for all children and parents or guardians are required to sign-in and sign-out their children on each day they attend the camp.

All campers have a unique reference number issued to them when booking and this number must be quoted when collecting in order for staff to release children.

FOOD & DRINK:

We do not provide lunch on any of our camps however we do provide drinks and snacks such as - Water, squash, biscuits, energy bars and dried fruit.

For full day attendees a packed lunch should be sent with your child. We recommend that the drinks you provide are non fizzy and you try to make the lunch as nutritionally balanced and wholesome as possible giving them energy to take part in all the activities on offer.

CLOTHING AND EQUIPMENT

Children must bring the appropriate footwear for both indoor and outdoor activities, please note outdoor shoes will not be allowed in sports halls. It is important to send waterproof and warm clothing also in case of inclement weather conditions. A change of clothing for wet-day activities and in case of accidents is also required.

If players are taking part in our Football, Rugby, Cricket and Hockey academies the correct safety equipment must be worn for the child to participate.

Activate Sport provide ALL equipment for each of our programmes, however children are welcome to bring their favourite hockey stick or cricket bat for example.

Please note Activate Sport cannot take responsibility for items that are lost on camps however we will endeavour to return any items found that are clearly marked or labelled.
